This request for expressions of interest follows the General Procurement Notice for the Road Sector Program Support Project that appeared in UN Development Business and dgMarket on September 26, 2009.

The Government of the Republic of Moldova has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA) towards the cost of the Moldova Road Sector Program Support Project and it intends to apply a portion of the financing proceeds to payments for consulting services for:

- Elaboration of **National Environmental Road Handbook**; and
- Conducting the **Public awareness activities**.

The key objectives of the consulting services are to prepare:

- A. The full version of National Environmental Handbook; and
- B. Several environmentally oriented leaflets, booklets and placards, reflecting major environmental findings obtained during the project implementation and designated to provide information for public and NGOs community.

- Experience in working with the World Bank or other international agencies;
- Fluent in written and oral communication in Romanian, English and Russian;
