Assignment Title: Social Survey for Local Road Improvement Project

Assignment description:

The Government of the Republic of Moldova has applied for financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Local Roads Improvement Project in Moldova, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The project will be implemented under the general supervision and responsibility of the Ministry of Infrastructure and Regional Development (MIRD), who will execute the project through the State Road Administration (SRA) as the direct executing agency.

The consulting services ("the Services") include survey and analysis works for the selected LRIP Project communities and road sections before implementation of road rehabilitation works and analysis of the actual situation and expected impact of the LRIP Project on different social groups (including men, women, youth, elderly, unemployed, disabled, etc.) in selected beneficiary communities – for newly intended corridors. At the same time to interview the beneficiaries from the localities about the level of road conditions and opportunities for population in already rehabilitated corridors during 2017-2023.

On a general level, the social surveys study should try:

- 1. To examines how the project can contribute towards regional development and job creation in some of Moldova's most road users' regions, thereby helping them to converge with the rest of the country and ensuring that the sustainable benefit from inclusive growth. In this regard, the proposed activities should: i) help improve the understanding on what are the connectivity and mobility constraints that various social groups in the local population face and what types of complimentary interventions could be needed to ignite growth and improve service delivery to each of these groups; ii) identify channels through which the project's citizen engagement strategy could incorporate the preferences of the different social groups into the project design, and iii) help SRA to take best augmented solution for road rehabilitation with biggest benefit for population and regional development.
- 2. To evaluate the level of satisfaction of population in the area of implemented LRIP corridors. In this context, in July 2017, an opinion poll was conducted to establish and evaluate the initial situation and the expectations of the population. According to the Monitorization System based on indicators, which are implemented within the Project, in early 2023 another similar survey of opinions will be conducted to measure the level of satisfaction of the population regarding the implementation of the Local Road Improvement Project of the last 4 years. It must show what is the opinion of the people regarding the works carried out, the quality of the infrastructure, how the life of the

localities has changed due to the rehabilitated road, the access to social institutions, but also what new opportunities are created.

On all phases of the assignment, the consultant will give special attention to sub-groups, disaggregating to the extent possible, predominant trends, patterns, and issues affecting women, the elderly, the disabled, unemployed, youth, small-scale farmers, among other target population groups.

The social survey and analyses shall be done in two phases:

I. Initial situation and assessing the pre-project status

A total of 40 representative/settlements located within the **proposed corridors project's area** will be selected by the SRA and the Bank in close consultation with the hired firm. Survey and analysis work for the selected communities will involve data collection and analysis socio-economic conditions and living standards of the population in selected beneficiary communities to allow *for the understanding of the initial situation and assessing the pre- project status*. In this phase, the Consultant shall:

- Review the socio-economic baseline information regarding selected beneficiary communities available with the National Statistical Bureau of the Republic of Moldova, regional and local authorities, project stakeholders etc. Based on this information the Consultant will determine the sampling plan for the conduct of pre-project survey.
- Conduct Household Survey in localities;
- Prepare the Social Survey Study Report that shall present the socio-economic conditions of the population of selected beneficiary communities, their perceptions and views with respect to proposed LRIP Project activities.

II. Satisfaction survey

A total of 30 representative/settlements located within **the actual corridors LRIP project's area** will be selected by the SRA and the Bank in close consultation with the hired firm. Survey and analysis work for the selected communities will involve data collection and analysis of socio-economic conditions and living standards of the population in selected beneficiary communities to allow for the understanding of the actual situation and assessing the **post-project status**. In this phase, the Consultant shall:

- Review the socio-economic baseline information regarding selected beneficiary communities available in previous survey and with the National Statistical Bureau of the Republic of Moldova, regional and local authorities, project stakeholders etc. Based on this information the Consultant will determine the sampling plan for the conduct of postproject survey.
- Conduct Household Survey in localities;
- Prepare the Social Survey Study Report that shall present the socio-economic conditions
 of the population of selected beneficiary communities, their perceptions and views with
 respect to changes and opportunities due to LRIP Project activities implemented.

Assignment start and duration:

The assignment is expected to start in May 2023 and last 2 months

Requirements for Expression of Interests (EOIs):

The State Road Administration now invites eligible consulting firms ("Consultants") to indicate their interest in providing the Services. Interested Consultants should provide information demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services.

Expressions of interests (EOIs) may be submitted by a firm, association, or a joint venture. For shortlisting purposes, the combined experience of an association or a joint venture will be evaluated although the qualifications of the lead firm will be given a greater weight.

In order to determine the capability and experience of consulting firms seeking to be qualified, the information submitted with the Expression of Interest shall include the following:

1. Company Profile:

- Company profile, core business, staffing levels and technical capacity, annual turnover;
- Details of firm's/association's/joint venture's standard quality policies, procedures and practices;
- Name, qualifications and relevant experience of firm's director or manager who will assume overall responsibility for the firm's, association's or joint venture's team coordination, management and output;
- Specific details of firm's/association's/join venture's procedures to ensure quality of its performance over the life of this assignment including management coordination and role of each firm.

2. Company Experience:

Provide up to 10 project references in similar social survey study assignments, undertaken in the past 5 years¹ (<u>started and successfully completed in the related period</u>), which the firm/association/joint venture considers that best illustrate its experience relevant to the assignment, to include the following details:

- Project title and narrative description of the project;
- Contractual role of the firm;
- Detailed description of the actual services provided by the firm;
- Name of firm's senior staff (Project Manager, Team Leader) involved and function performed;
- Number of staff and number of person-months of professional staff provided by the firm:
- The presence of any lead or affiliate companies and their respective roles;
- Detailed description of the actual services provided by associate companies;
- Number of staff and number of person-months of professional staff provided by affiliate companies;
- Location, and start and completion dates;
- Contract value;
- Name of the Client and funding source, with which procurement rules, e.g. IFIs', were applied.

Contracts that have been completed prior to this cut-off date will not be considered.

In case more than 10 project references will be provided, only first 10 will be taken into consideration during evaluation. These should be the most relevant 10 projects the Consultant believes will best demonstrate their fit for the assignment.

The information on the company's profile shall be submitted in accordance with Table 1 and the information on company's experience in accordance with Table 2 of the attached Annex 1.

The Expression of interest is to be in English language and should not exceed 50 pages.

The final percentage to be allocated will be determined following a quantitative and qualitative evaluation of the submitted Proposals and related information under each abovementioned criterion.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans & IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers, January 2011 ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest. Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub consultancy to enhance their qualifications.

Procurement procedure:

The best qualified and experienced firm will be selected in accordance with the CQS (Selection based on Consultant's Qualification) method set out in the Guidelines mentioned above. Only the selected firm will be asked to submit a combined technical and financial proposal.
