Section 1: Letter of Invitation

The Government of the Republic of Moldova has received financing from the European Investment Bank (the "Bank") in the form of a credit toward the cost of MOLDOVA ROADS IIIB, for procurement of supervision services for "Rehabilitation Works on R34 Hincesti-Leova-Cahul-Giurgiulesti road, km 82+000 – km 125+000". The Î.S. "Administrația de Stat a Drumurilor" (hereinafter called "Client", "Promoter" or "SRA"), an implementing agency of the Ministry of Infrastructure and Regional Development, intends to apply a portion of the proceeds of this credit to eligible payments under the Contract for which this Request for Proposals is issued.

No party other than the Client shall derive any rights from the financing agreement or have any claims to the proceeds of the credit.

The Client now invites proposals to provide the following consulting services (hereinafter called "Services"): <u>Supervision of Rehabilitation Works on R34 Hincesti-Leova-Cahul-Giurgiulesti road, km 82+000 – km 125+000</u>.

It is expected that the assignment will commence in February 2024 and last about 58 months, which includes 1 month for pre-Commencement activities, 30 months of works supervision, 24 months covering defects notification period and 3 months for the Performance Certificate issue and other closing activities. The time period may be changed by written agreement between the parties.
